

Virtual Services Addendum

Under certain circumstances, you and your family support professional may agree to conduct visits using interactive video calls (IVC) or phone calls.

Your family support professional may want to text you handouts and other materials to use during a visit.

Your family support professional may also ask you to send photos or video of you and your child engaging in an activity that was discussed during one of the visits. The purpose of sharing photos or video is to help the family support professional continue to observe and support your family and your relationship with your children. He or she will be using a work issued phone and will delete any photos or video you send them after they view them.

Your family support professional may ask to audio or video record a visit so they can review the visit later and with their supervisor. Any audio or video recordings will also be deleted once viewed.

You can still receive virtual visits even if you do not give permission for texting materials, photos, or videos or for our virtual visits to be audio or video recorded.
